Conditions of Acceptance

1. Attendance at class, schedule activities, and excursions is compulsory.
2. The use of alcohol, drugs or other prescribed substances is **strictly forbidden**. Students found in possession of alcohol, drugs or other prescribed substances **will be sent home immediately at parents'/guardians' expense**. Parents/guardians will be advised of the termination of the student's stay and must make arrangements for the student's immediate return home. No refund of fees will be permitted in this circumstance.
3. Under the provisions of Irish law, young people under the age of 18 years of age may not visit public houses (pubs) and they may not purchase alcohol.
4. A student is responsible for any damage or injury he/she may cause to buildings, furniture, fittings, individuals' or host family property, etc., while registered with Donegal English Language School. The student and his/her parents/guardians will be responsible for the repair, replacement or reimbursement of any damaged property
5. Where theft of any nature occurs the matter will be referred to the police, An Garda Síochána, who will investigate the matter and deal with it according to Irish legal procedures. A serious misdemeanour or infringement of the laws of Ireland will result in instant dismissal from the school. Costs incurred by the student as a result of dismissal from the school are the sole responsibility of the student and his/her parents/guardians. Donegal English Language School will accept no liability of any kind.
6. All students are subject to a curfew: students in residential are only permitted to leave campus on a Sunday between 11am – 4 pm. If staying in host family they must be at their nominated host family by 9pm each night

7. Covid 19

We HIGHLY recommend all students to come to Ireland fully vaccinated. If students are unable to be vaccinated for health or other reasons, they must take an antigen test before arrival and only come into the country if this test is negative.

All students should bring at least 3 antigen tests with them to Ireland in case of a suspected case of Covid 19. If a student has Covid 19 symptoms they should remain in their room alone and take the antigen test brought with them from their home country.

If a student tests positive for Covid 19 while with us, they will remain in isolation in their host family until they test negative. The same rule applies to host families, if a member of the host family tests positive for Covid 19, the student must remain in the same host family and continue to attend school unless they test positive.

Security Deposit

Each group pay a security deposit of €500. This money is refunded at the end of stay on the condition that no damage is caused to school materials or property by the group or an individual within the group

Insurance

It is compulsory to have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). This is free for all European countries and will cover any doctor or hospital appointments in the case of any medical issues. It is also compulsory for all clients to have medical insurance.

You must have sufficient cover in the case of your student getting Covid while here in Ireland. It must cover the following: flights, airport transfers, accommodation including food, a parent travelling to Ireland to collect the student (if a minor). If you don't have a policy, please contact us for more details on the Guardme policy. If your own insurance policy covers the same then please send us proof of this insurance or send proof of Guardme policy.
